Timings: From 1000 hours to 1400 hours

2. Following is the list of services for which applicants can walk-in (**subject to availability of time and space**), for interview and signature of applications, in front of the Embassy's Consular Officer:

- a) Renunciation of citizenship
- b) Issuance / Reissuance of passport
- c) Attestation of Power of Attorney / Affidavit / Self-declaration / Annexure M
- d) Registration of Birth
- e) Continuity of Marriage
- f) Life Certificate / Pension Certificate / No Pension Certificate
- g) Immigration Movement Certificate
- h) NRI Certificate
- i) Out of wedlock declaration
- j) OCI Lost case

3. The Embassy's officer would also verify the copies of the original documents such as Passport, NIE, Empadromiento etc. The application complete in all respects, may be handed over to the Embassy's Officer at the same time. However, these applications would be processed further only after receipt of prescribed fees in VFS Global. Incomplete applications would not be accepted. In such cases, completed applications along with all supporting documents, could later be sent to VFS Global by post/courier.
