4. **Mode of Tender.** Global Tender Enquiry (GTE) (TWO BID SYSTEM).

5. **Earnest Money Deposit.** Item wise EMD submission bidding is allowed. The Appendices "C, D" of RFP have specified the EMD amount to be submitted for each spare/assy. The total EMD to be submitted by the bidder will be the sum of all the individual values of each spare/assy as specified in the EMD column of the Appendices "C, D" which is being offered by the Bidder. EMD shall be prepared in the name of 'The President of India' payable at New Delhi alongwith their Technical Bids. The EMD may be submitted in the form of an Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt, Banker's Cheque or Bank Guarantee from any of the public sector banks or a private sector bank authorized to conduct government business as per Form DPM-13 (Available in MoD website and can be provided on request). EMD is to remain valid for a period of forty-five days beyond the final bid validity period. EMD of the unsuccessful bidders will be returned to them at the earliest after expiry of the final bid validity and latest on or before the 30th day after the award of the contract. The Bid Security of the successful bidder would be returned, without any interest whatsoever, after the receipt of Performance Security from them as called for in the contract. EMD is not required to be submitted by those Bidders who are registered for the same item/range of product/goods or service with the Central Purchase Organization (e.g. DGS&D), National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC) or any Department of MoD or MoD itself. The EMD will be forfeited if the bidder withdraws or amends impairs or derogates from the tender in any respect within the validity period of their tender.
